E- learning is an important and essential component of teaching which makes teaching learning process both interesting and interactive. In the academic session 2021-22, the school has been primarily working in an online mode in accordance with the Government Regulations. All classes and students were in touch with their class in charges and subject teachers through Google meet, Google forms, Video presentations, you tube videos and many other virtual modes. Efforts were being made to ensure that all students actively participated in the online mode and ensured maximum learning outcomes. Teachers conducted their online lectures with attractive and informative Power Point presentations, online activities and even conducted the Periodic tests and examinations through the online medium.

When the school reopened physically, all precautions of sanitization, thermal checking, wearing masks and social distancing were maintained. Care was also taken to ensure that the staff was vaccinated well in advance to provide a safe and secure school environment. Once the students got back into the daily routine of regular classes students of age group 15-18 years were vaccinated with both doses.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION

Environmental education is a part of the day to day lessons being taught and the aspect is being stressed at through different medium and activities through out the academic year.

The school has taken up many initiatives to inculcate and promote the love for nature and environment amongst its students and teachers.

- The school has imposed a complete ban on the use of plastic bags in the school. As a substitute to plastic bags, students were made to create their own jute bags in the art and craft class.
- The school undertakes the segregation of waste at source and recycling and proper discharge of water.
- The school has taken up WATER AUDIT (AT SCHOOL AND HOME) as a SEWA project for classes IX and X to make students aware of the usage and wastage of water by students. Students, themselves, bring up new ideas and take steps to reduce wastage of water at every step in the school.

- The school promotes the idea of planting a tree by the students each year. This brings the idea of belonging and keeping them motivated to take care of that plant/ tree throughout the year.
- The school uses energy saving electrical appliances.
- The school maintains a green look with lots and lots of plantation in and around the school.
- The school also has a unique program of BIRD AND ANIMAL FEEDERS around the school vicinity. This program is run by the students of the ECO CLUB. Under this program, students place FEEDERS for birds and animals for water and food at different places around their homes and the school. It's the responsibility of students to keep these FEEDERS filled with water and food for birds and animals.

## PARENT – TEACHER'S ASSOCIATION

A general body meeting of parents is held on a regular basis and new members of the PTA were nominated for the year 2021-22.

Since PTA meetings have been arranged periodically, the PTA members of our school are closely involved in most academic activities. We thank and congratulate them for their support and cooperation through the years.
